

Speaking of ESS, the app is available to download on your phone. Here are the instructions:

- Log in to Employee Portal as you normally would on a desktop or mobile browser
- 2. Click the arrow next to your profile image and click "Account Settings".
- 3. Click on the "MOBILE APP" tab. You will see your six-digit access code which will be required the first time you open the PrismHR Employee Portal mobile app.
- 4. The PrismHR Employee Portal Mobile App is available for Apple (App Store) and Android devices (Google Play).
- Next, you will be required to complete a one-time setup to access your account.
- Open the app and set up access using either one of the following options:
 - Scan the QR Code from your Account Settings page or
 - Enter the Access Code from your Account Settings page


